**STATE OF EMERGENCY RELATING TO  
EMERGENCY AUTHORITY FOR PHARMACISTS**

WHEREAS, beginning on February 15, 2015, and continuing, a severe winter storm with significant snow fall accumulation, bitterly cold air and sub zero wind chills began tracking across the Commonwealth, with severe impacts to infrastructure, governmental properties, and private properties; and

WHEREAS, these conditions continue to endanger public health and safety; and

WHEREAS, I, Steven L. Beshear, Governor of the Commonwealth of Kentucky, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Kentucky and by Chapter 39A of the Kentucky Revised Statutes, did declare by Executive Order on February 16, 2015, a State of Emergency; and

WHEREAS, under such circumstances, I am further empowered by the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Kentucky and Chapter 315 of the Kentucky Revised Statutes to implement certain provisions of law aimed toward further protecting the health and welfare of Kentucky citizens:

NOW THEREFORE, I, Steven L. Beshear, by virtue of authority vested in me pursuant to the Constitution of Kentucky and by Chapter 315 of the Kentucky Revised Statutes, do hereby implement the provisions of KRS 315.500 *et seq* as to the emergency authority for pharmacists, and do hereby ORDER and DIRECT that:

1. In accordance with the provisions of KRS 315.500 and 201 KAR 2:330, pharmacists located in any county in the Commonwealth of Kentucky may dispense emergency refills of up to a thirty (30) day supply of any non-scheduled medication for residents of any county of the Commonwealth.
