CALL TO ORDER A public hearing on 201 KAR 2:076 was held at the Kentucky Transportation Building in Frankfort, KY. President Greenwell called the meeting to order on June 28, 2017 at 9:13 a.m.

Ashley Klevens thanked the Board for their work and stated that Kentucky has the most responsive, open pharmacy board in the nation.

Dr. Hanna moved to submit the regulation as drafted and filed. Dr. Martin seconded, and the motion passed unanimously.

President Greenwell stated that any written comments should be submitted by the end of June and will be discussed at the regular meeting scheduled for July 12, 2017.
