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Present: Chair Chris Killmeier; Council Members Michael Wyant, Taryn Harris, Matt Martin, Sarah Lawrence and Shannon Stiglitz. Staff present were Executive Director Larry Hadley and Darla Sayre, Executive Staff Advisor. Visitors present were KPhA President Chris Palutis, KPhA Executive Director Mark Glasper, Elizabeth Lovell, Adam Chesler, Cardinal Health and Lavanya Peters from Park DuValle Health Center. Absent: Kelly Whitaker, Joe Bickett and Lisa Hart.

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Killmeier at 10:01 am.

On motion by Michael Wyant, seconded by Sarah Lawrence, and passed unanimously, the minutes from the August 15, 2018 meeting were approved.

Mr. Killmeier read the working definition approved at the last meeting: Telepharmacy is the practice of pharmacy using automation or technology.

Mr. Hadley presented definitions of home pharmacy and remote pharmacy from other states. His research indicated that 'home pharmacy' was indicative of pharmacy home delivery programs. The term 'remote pharmacy' was more in line with telepharmacy.

After much discussion, Matt Martin proposed to work on the draft utilizing the white board at the next meeting. Mr. Killmeier offered to compose the working draft for the meeting to include the recommendations that have been discussed.

Mr. Hadley gave a summary of the issue of failed NAPLEX attempts. NABP guidelines require state approval for additional test attempts after five failures. The Board has no regulatory citation to prohibit additional attempts. After much discussion, Dr. Martin moved to direct Mr. Hadley to have Cheryl Lalonde, General Counsel draft regulation amendments to 201 KAR 2:020 with the following:

1. After three failed attempts at the NAPLEX, the applicant shall petition the Board for approval to sit for the exam providing additional work experience, education, work study or other preparation completed.
2. After five failed attempts at the NAPLEX, the applicant is not allowed additional test attempts.

Mr. Wyant seconded, and the motion passed unanimously.

Mr. Killmeier asked for nomination for Chair of the Council. Ms. Stiglitz recommended Matt Martin to serve as Chair. Dr. Martin accepted the nomination. Ms. Stiglitz moved to appoint Dr. Martin as Chair of the Council. Mr. Wyant seconded, and the motion passed unanimously.

The next meeting will be held on January 15, 2018. The time will be determined at a later date dependent upon member availability. Mr. Killmeier directed Mr. Hadley to draft a proposed 2019 meeting schedule to be presented at the January meeting.

Mr. Hadley thanked Chris Killmeier, Taryn Harris, Joe Bickett and Lisa Hart for their years of service and dedication to the Council.

The meeting was adjourned at 11:44 pm by motion of Michael Wyant and seconded by Taryn Harris. The vote was unanimous.
