**Pursuant to Executive Order 220-243, the Kentucky Board of Pharmacy has made the following amendments to regulations for the duration of the state of emergency due to COVID-19.**

### **201 KAR 2: 370**

Section 2 (g) and Section 4 (d) (5) During the State of Emergency, all medications stocked in an ADS and all medications in the LTCF drug stock may be performed by licensed nursing personnel. This shall only be effective during the State of Emergency.

### **201 KAR 2: 280**

Section 1 (c) A pharmacist may perform therapeutic interchange, as defined in 201 KAR 2:116 Section 1, if the prescribed product is in short supply per the FDA Drug Shortage List. Pharmacist must inform prescriber of therapeutic interchange within 2 business days or next day prescriber can be reached. This shall only be effective during the State of Emergency.

### **201 KAR 2:205**

Section 2 (d) During the State of Emergency, a pharmacy may request an extension from the Board of Pharmacy of the fourteen (14) calendar day written notification requirement of any change in the employment of the pharmacist-in-charge, employment of staff pharmacist and schedule of hours.

### **201 KAR 2:020**

Section 8 (1) Suspend, for the duration of the State of Emergency, the requirement that the "Initial Application for Pharmacist Licensure" be notarized.
