

Temporary Licensure/Registration due to COVID-19

Steps for temporary pharmacist licensure:

1. Pharmacist requests temporary licensure via NABP eProfile using [NABP Passport Program](#).
2. Pharmacist submits initial licensure application [fee is waived] with a letter of explanation indicating state of licensure, license number and online verification obtained from resident state.
3. Upon receipt, Board staff will verify pharmacist has a license in good standing in their state of residence.
4. Board staff will issue a pharmacist license with an expiration date of 90 days or termination of the state of emergency.

Steps for temporary pharmacy technician registration if registered or licensed in state of residence:

1. Pharmacy technician request temporary registration via NABP eProfile using [NABP Passport Program](#).
2. Pharmacy technician submits paper application [fee is waived] with letter of explanation indicating resident state of licensure/registration, license/registration number and online verification obtained from resident state.
3. Upon receipt, Board staff will verify license/registration is in good standing in their state of residence.
4. Board staff will issue a pharmacy technician registration with an expiration date of 90 days or termination of the state of emergency.

Pharmacy technicians not currently registered or licensed in any state should follow the normal procedure [including fee] to obtain a registration at www.pharmacy.ky.gov.
